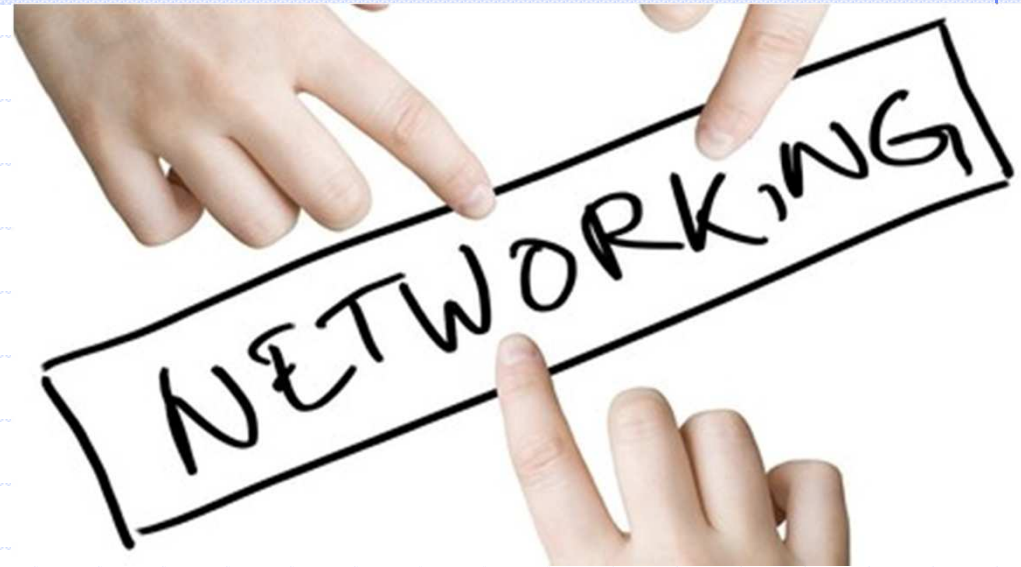


Who we are?
