

Dear All.

The European nuclear young generation network organizes every two year the major event ENYGF (European Nuclear Young Generation Forum). The 2015 edition will take place in Paris from June 22nd to 26th around the theme "Nuclear and Environment".

With its 400 expected participants, this conference will allow the young generation to express their opinion on nuclear in order to influence the debates of the international climate conference COP 21 which will be held in Paris in December 2015. The event will be composed of three days of lectures in Paris, one day of technical visits and one day of cultural visits, all of it in a friendly atmosphere.

During the lectures, we will organize workshops: the idea of the ENYGF workshops is to be interactive with a small group of participants (between 30 and 40). The workshop participants will perform a task (e.g.: a game or brainstorming session) and present the output. Each workshop will be managed by a "Workshop Manager."

It is expected that the manager will perform the following tasks:

- Develop the given workshop based on the given topic in coordination with the ENYGF workshop chair,
- Contact speakers and companies that will participate in that workshop,
- Be present at the conference (supported by her/his company) to lead the workshop.

The output will be presented during the conference's closing session. The workshop organizers may be Young Generation professionals, as well as senior professionals from inside or outside the nuclear industry.
